Concert venues include Bridgewater Hall, Royal Northern College of Music, Gorton Monastery, Stoller Hall, Manchester Cathedral and St George's Church Stockport, and the Choir tours regularly in the UK and overseas.

About Neil Taylor

Neil is a sought-after and renowned choral director, organist, piano accompanist, teacher and coach, based in the north west of England. After winning a scholarship to the Royal College of Music, he held appointments at St Albans and Norwich cathedrals, and was Organist and Director of Music at Sheffield Cathedral from 1997 to 2016, during which time the cathedral choir toured both at home and abroad and broadcast frequently on BBC Radios 2 and 3. His CD recordings include *Music for a Millennium*, a *Classic FM* magazine 'CD of the Year' award winner, and nine critically-acclaimed CD recordings with the cathedral choir. As solo organist, he has played at many major UK venues, and has worked with the Hallé, Royal Liverpool Philharmonic, Royal Northern Sinfonia and Welsh National Opera orchestras. As well as Musical Director of St George's Singers, Neil is also MD of The Sheffield Chorale, Artistic Director of the Keele Bach Choir, and appears frequently with the BBC as Musical Director and Organist on BBC *Songs of Praise*, *Daily Service* and *Sunday Worship*.

About the music

John Rutter, recognised by many principally as a celebrated composer of Christmas carols, and regarded by David Willcocks as 'the most gifted composer of his generation', has also achieved international success with his longer works: the *Gloria*, the *Magnificat*, and most especially, the *Requiem*. Composed in 1985 in response to a personal bereavement, the *Requiem* was premiered by the Fox Valley Festival Chorus in Illinois the same year. It is not a complete setting of the Mass for the Dead, but a meditation on themes of life and death, using Rutter's own selection of texts drawn from the Requiem Mass and the 1662 Book of Common Prayer. A concert work rather than a liturgical Requiem, it was chosen for performance at the many memorial services held across the United States following the tragic events of 9/11, bringing with it a message of hope and comfort.

Rutter's music is effortlessly singable, which doesn't mean that musical director Neil Taylor will be satisfied with anything other than 110% energy and enthusiasm from all the singers – with Pete Durrant, our indefatigable one-man orchestra, leading the way!
