Neil Taylor is a sought-after and renowned choral director, organist, piano accompanist, teacher and coach. He is Music Director of St George's Singers and Keele Bach Choir; he appears regularly with the BBC as Musical Director and Organist on *Songs of Praise*, the BBC *Young Chorister of the Year* finals, the *Daily Service*, and *Sunday Worship*. His recordings include *Music for a Millennium*, a *Classic FM* magazine 'Disc of the Year' award winner, and numerous releases as organist and conductor, all to high critical acclaim. As solo organist, he has worked with the Hallé Orchestra, Northern Chamber Orchestra, Manchester Camerata, Royal Liverpool Philharmonic Orchestra, Royal Northern Sinfonia, the Orchestra of Opera North, Huddersfield Choral Society, and the Orchestra of Welsh National Opera.

Singing Day: Live or online!

Following the success of our 2021 Virtual Singing Day, this year's Singing Day will be both live AND streamed via Zoom. So you can choose to join us in person in Poynton or sing along with us online.

Live event

The following procedures will be in place on the day:

- All participants are expected to have taken a lateral flow test before coming to the event.
- Masks should be worn on entering, leaving and moving around the Church and Church Hall.
- Numbers of participants will be limited to provide more space for each singer.
- The Church and Church Hall will be ventilated throughout the day.
- To minimise queues, all food and drink will be pre-portioned, individually wrapped/ready served in cups.

Streamed event

Once you have registered, we will send you the link to access the streamed event. You do not need to have Zoom loaded on your PC/tablet.

About the Music

Igor Stravinsky (1882–1971) was born near St Petersburg, but moved to Switzerland, then France, before settling in the United States where he became a naturalised US citizen. The *Symphony of Psalms* was commissioned by Boston Symphony Orchestra in 1930, when Stravinsky was living in Nice, during what is described as his neo-classical period. At this time of his life Stravinsky was an observant Orthodox believer, and his treatment of the Psalms reflects the depth of his religious belief. The work is in three movements and sets the words of Psalms 39, 40 and 150, the first two dealing with human penitence, sinfulness and longed-for salvation, the third and longest movement celebrating God through music. There are references to classical styles as well as moments that resonate with Stravinsky's recent music. But it is the new sounds, forms and shapes of the *Symphony of Psalms* that define the piece as a sincere expression of the composer's unique approach to the Psalms. In his own words: 'It is not a symphony in which I have included Psalms to be sung; it is the singing of the Psalms that I am symphonising.'
