Dear Friends

We were overjoyed to begin live rehearsals on 7th September 2021 for our 65th season, after an 18-month break. Covid-19 forced us to cancel 55 rehearsals, 7 concerts, 2 choir tours and a Singing Day (although that still went ahead virtually – twice!). All the performing arts have been hit hard by the pandemic, but the Choir is vaccinated, tested and raring to go. Our return to live music brings you a season of concerts with the WOW factor!

Our first concert is a joyful return to singing with music covering nearly 500 years, from Byrd to Tormis: music to bring a smile to your face and joy in your heart. Music shared live with each other – again!

Carols by Candlelight welcomes in the Christmas season with festive music – accompanied as usual by mince pies and mulled wine. The *Symphony of Psalms*, our Singing Day music, is arguably one of the most deeply moving and spiritual pieces Stravinsky wrote. Come to Poynton for the day to work with Neil on this amazing and rewarding music – but apply early. We usually sell out!

Few classical works have the urgency and dramatic immediacy of Bach's *St John Passion*, which takes you on an emotional roller-coaster, swept in by the beauty of the opening chorus, racked by haunting solos, frightened by vicious crowd scenes and soothed by sublime music of gentle reflection and meditation.

By contrast, Walton's *Belshazzar's Feast* is astonishingly vivid and colourful, now established as one of the pinnacles of 20th-century choral music. It's so good in fact, that we are performing it twice – you can be enthralled by it at Huddersfield Town Hall and then be delighted by it a second time the following week at Gorton Monastery, in a very different environment.

2021–22 promises a season of wonderful music which we hope to share again with you, our audience. I look forward to seeing you all.
